Define a product to be developed, marketing of product or educational curricula or program. Include in this a description of goals and objectives, who will benefit and how lifestyles will be improved.
- () Four copies of specific costs, grant budget and a timeline for the project.
- () Four copies of a detailed description of the project being undertaken--with photos or illustrations if available and what role you would play.
- () Four copies of a letter of recommendation from an associate aware of your abilities and interest in the project.
- () Four copies of this completed application form.
