- Five copies of a 200-400 word essay explaining your long and short term goals, special interests, volunteer /community service, and what inspired you to pursue a professional career in this field.
- Five copies of five different examples of your original furniture designs, whether built or detailed sketches. Digital color copies or CD's acceptable.
- Five copies of a letter of recommendation from an instructor/professor on official school stationery.
